

WEDNESDAY NIGHT LEAGUE RULES 2026

HANDICAP

- Player handicaps will be carried over from last year.
- Handicaps will be calculated using the most current 4 weeks of current season.

Those players who DO NOT have a handicap will establish their handicap using their score minus 35, and multiplying by 90%.

- Subs that participate in league without a handicap will need to be positioned before play begins.
- Position Rounds - All players participating must have a handicap, FROM Wed night league NO EXCEPTION
- No more than one stroke per hole will be given regardless of handicap difference for match play (hole by hole play).

POINTS

- One point for match play per player. One point for individual low net per player, using 1 decimal point. Three points for team low net. Team net will be calculated with one decimal point
- Points will be awarded for team and individual play.
- There are eleven points possible each week of play.
- All ties will result in split points.
- Score sheets are to be filled out by both teams and signed by one player from each team. Signed score sheets are final, so make sure they are right!
- If a player cannot be there for their match and fails to have a substitute, they forfeit their net and match play points. If a player shows up late they will still forfeit their net points (forfeiting the holes missed). But the player will have the opportunity to catch up with the group to play for the remaining match play points. By not showing up or showing up late the team will automatically forfeit the three possible team points. Even if the opposing team agrees to wait, the team that is late still loses appropriate points.

RULES

USGA RULES APPLY EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING LOCAL LEAGUE RULES:

- Tees: Men 64 under play white tees. Men 65 and over plus may play from the Gold Tees, 75 and over may play red tees Women play Red Tees. Players MUST play from the same set of tees all season.
- GIMMIES are allowed only given by players opponent CONTINUOUS PUTTING IN STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
- Out of bounds and lost ball in wooded area and/or tall grass: One stroke penalty and ball must be dropped and played from point of entry. (Line of flight no closer to hole).
- Water hazard: -One stroke penalty and use drop area. Drop areas are located Number 7 on the right side of the green near the tress by the pond, on #8 the flat area right of the green above the pond
- MAXIMUM OF 3 MINUTES LOOKING FOR A LOST BALL
- WINTER RULES APPLY THROUGH THE GREEN
- BUNKERS: Bunkers will be played as Ground Under Repair.
- MAX SCORE OF DOUBLE PAR PER HOLE
- MAX HANDICAP of 18. ONLY 1 STROKE CAN BE TAKEN ON EACH HOLE IN THE HEAD TO HEAD MATCH
- EACH WEEK PLAYERS WILL BE PAIRED ON AN ABCD ROTATING BASIS – A/B & C/D, A/C & B/D, A/D & B/C
